How to use this workbook

You will be expected to work through this booklet whilst you are off. It will include much of the information that you have been learning about in your PER lessons as well as new content that you may not have covered yet.

Information

This booklet will contain all the information you will need and you will not be required to do online research. The information will always be presented in the simplest way possible, with images to support and additional explanations to give you the best opportunity to learn. However, you may wish to do online research on some information that you do not fully understand or if you are interested.

Questions

Each section will contain information and questions or tasks for you to complete. Some tasks are to help you start to think about the topic.

There are also three different types of questions:

- **Green questions:** These are comprehension questions that test whether you have read and understood the information present.
- **Blue questions:** These are to test deeper understanding of information, you will be expected to analyse and interpret quotes, actions and text.
- **Purple questions:** These expect you to evaluate information present, you will have to provide detail answers and opinions. Sometimes you will be expected to weigh up how strong an argument is.

Now create your own storyboard with colourful images to recreate the parable of the sheep and the goats. Use the internet to find suitable images if you want to. The writing under the boxes tells you about that part of the story.

When God comes in glory, He will separate people like sheep and goats. The sheep on his right side and the goats on the left.	God invites the sheep into heaven with Him.
God tells the sheep that when he was in need of their help, they helped him.	God sends the goats to hell for eternal punishment.

God tells the goats that when he was need of their help, they did not help.	So, the goats live for eternity in punishment and the sheep live for eternity in paradise.
