TASK 3: Read the information and answer the question at the bottom of the text.

Water was a sign of repentance and making a new beginning. It was a familiar act for Jews to take ritual baths to make them 'pure' of the things that separated them from God.

This was a well-established tradition in the Qumran community – near the Dead Sea.

John thought people should do something special to show that they wanted to lead a Godly and good life.

Making promises wasn't enough – it had to be public and symbolic. He asked adults to be baptised and prepare themselves for the coming of the Messiah.

Why do you think John baptised people?

TASK 4: Look at the quotation- what is John predicting?

"I baptise you with water for repentance, but He who is coming after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will baptise you with the holy spirit instead."

Who is John referring to when he says He? Why do you think this?

What is John predicting?

Why do you think Mark began his gospel introducing John the Baptist?
