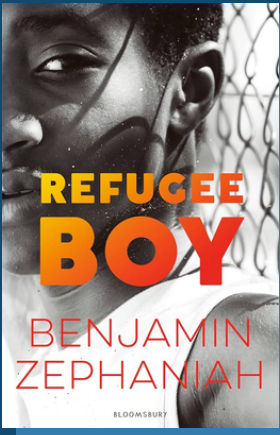


# Year 7 Wider Reading Suggestions

We Read



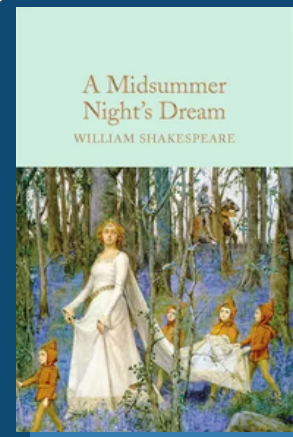
## You could read...

- **Refugee** - Alan Gratz  
Set over three time periods, the stories of three refugee teenagers alternate.
- **The Diary of Anne Frank**  
The real diary entries of a Jewish girl in hiding from the Nazis in World War 2.
- **Children of Blood and Bone** - Tomi Adeyemi  
In a West African inspired landscape, those with magic are persecuted and Zemie must fight to free them.
- **When Stars are Scattered** - Victoria Jamieson and Omar Mohamad  
A graphic novel of the true story of Omar Mohamad and his brother's experience as refugees in Somalia.

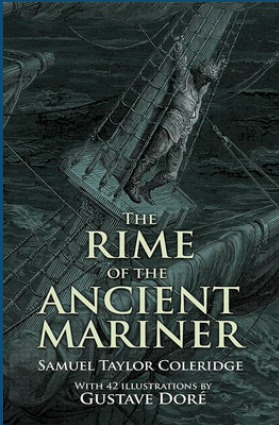
## You could read...

- **City of Stolen Magic** - Nazneen Ahmed Pathak  
Indian magic is being stamped out by the British rulers, so Chompa travels to England to find her mother and explore her powers.
- **The Night Circus** - Erin Morgenstern  
A mysterious and magical circus hides secrets and danger when two young magicians must duel to save the lives of the circus performers.
- **Legendborn** - Tracy Deonn  
Famous on Tiktok, this book is about a teenage girl called Bree, who discovers her magical powers and a secret society called the Legendborn.
- **The Iron King** - Julie Kagawa  
Meghan discovers she is the daughter of a fairy king, and has a part to play in a deadly war.

### You could read...

- **Why the Whales Came** - Michael Morpurgo  
Two children live on the tiny island of Bryher, along with the Mariner-like figure of the Birdman.
- **The Girl of Ink and Stars** - Kiran Millwood Hargrave  
Isabella, who is forbidden from leaving her island, journeys to find a missing friend through a magical and dangerous environment.
- **Alone on a Wide Wide Sea** - Michael Morpurgo  
Inspired by the poem, this story spans two generations of a family who travel from England to Australia and back again, finding love and friendship.
- **Where the World Ends** - Geraldine McCaughrean  
A boy and his friends are sent out to sea to hunt birds, and one summer are left to fend for themselves on the unforgiving ocean.

### You could read...

- **The Blue Book of Nebo** - Manon Steffon Ros  
Dylan and his mother live in an isolated Welsh village in a post apocalyptic future where electricity has gone off.
- **Diary of a Young Naturalist** - Dara McAnulty  
A diary written by the author, an autistic teenager who loves nature.
- **The Baker and the Bard** - Fern Haught  
A graphic novel set in a fantasy world where two friends journey through the woods to solve a mystery.
- **Journey to the River Sea** - Eva Ibbotson  
Maia, an orphan, journeys up the Amazon river to find her family, but finds more than she expected in the beauty of the jungle and a boy she meets there.
