Learn the animals — *Los animales*

Oh yes, and don't forget to learn if they go with 'un' or 'una'.

 un perro a dog	 un conejo a rabbit	 un gato a cat	 un ratón a mouse
 un hámster a hamster	 un pájaro a bird	 una tortuga a tortoise	 un caballo a horse

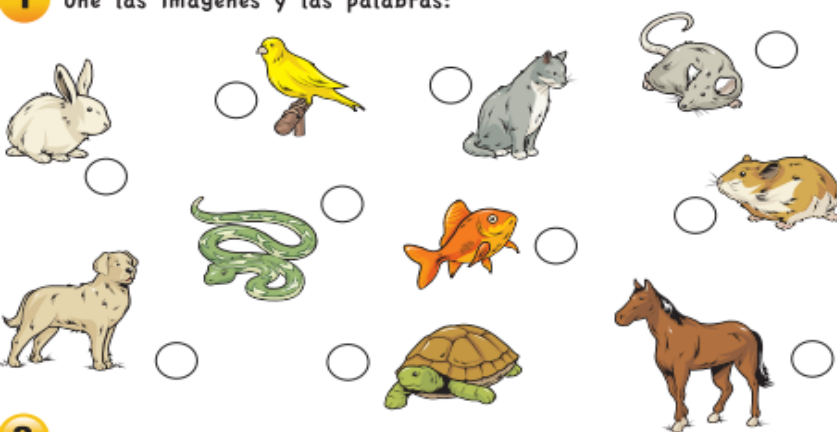

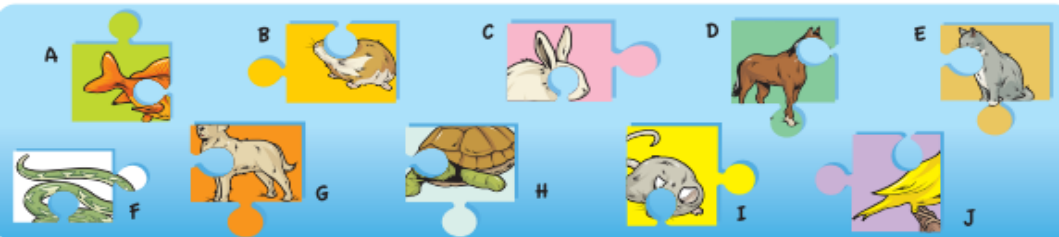

The Spanish word for 'the' also changes according to the gender of the noun and whether it is singular or plural.

	singular	plural
masculine	el conejo (the rabbit)	los conejos (the rabbits)
feminine	la cobaya (the guinea pig)	las cobayas (the guinea pigs)
