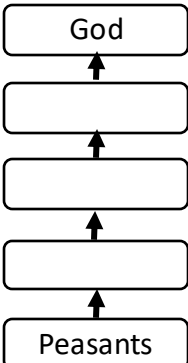

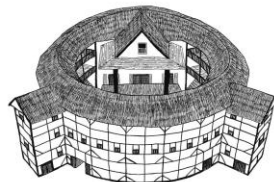

An Act for the Relief of the Poor.

BE it enacted by the Authority of this present Parliament, That the Churchwardens of every Parish, and four, three or two substantial Householdiers there, as shall be thought meet, having respect to the Proportion and Greatness of the same Parish and Parishes, to be nominated yearly in *Easter Week*, or within one Month after *Easter*, under the Hand and Seal of two or more Justices of the Peace in the same County, whereof one to be of the *Quorum*, dwelling in or near the same Parish or Division where the
